Ph.D. preferred; ABD considered. Responsibilities include teaching courses in the candidate's area of expertise, as well as Western Civilization courses as part of OBU's Core Curriculum. Candidates must be committed to the mission of OBU as a Christian liberal arts university.

- Teach both lower- and upper-level undergraduate history courses
- Serve as an advisor to history majors and minors
- Assist in recruiting students to the history program
- Keep accurate class records and submit reports and grades
- Keep regular office hours for advising students

- Support and guide student research and practice
- Work regularly with faculty members from other disciplines
