- Handle grade reports of players
- Organizes and maintains accurate inventory of soccer equipment and uniforms

• As assigned by the head soccer coach and the Director of Athletics

- Ability to recruit, coach and teach highly talented student athletes
- Ability to attend seminars, meetings and other professional development opportunities at or away from OBU
- Ability to organize work effectively, conceptualize and prioritize objectives and exercise activities

- Ability to represent the department and University in a friendly, courteous and professional manner
