# **Position Description**

## Resident Director, Taylor Residence Center and Village Women Apartments

**Department:** Office of Residential Life

### **Expectations for all employees**

## Purpose:

The purpose of this position is to oversee women that live in university housing by providing social engagement, leadership opportunity, academic support, physical challenge, and spiritual development. The position is a live-in (12 month) full-time professional position responsible for Taylor Residence Center and Women's Village Apartments.

#### **Essential Functions:**

- Provide residence hall-wide activities which promote educational, social, spiritual, and physical
  growth while ensuring that Resident Assistants provide activities in the same categories on their
  respective halls.
- Be aware of academic, physical, and emotional needs of individual residents and refer students to the proper sources when necessary, using models of challenge and support.
- Select, train, and supervise Resident Assistant staff to achieve the goal of individual student growth and achievement.
- Serve as a team member of the Campus Life Department by providing leadership opportunities for students through student activities.
- Oversee discipline of students based on policies in OBU Student Handbook. Maintain and communicate disciplinary cases with the Director of the Residential Experience and Dean of Students.
- Oversee all aspects of the administrative duties for the residence hall which include weekly
  newsletters, student payroll, facility check in-out, guest relations, and physical care of the facility.
- Manage room assignments, changes, related budgets, and assist in budget planning.
- Supervise physical maintenance of the Residence Hall including submission and tracking of maintenance requests.
- Working in collaboration with Spiritual Life as a frontline ministry associate in the residential facility.

#### Other Duties:

• Other duties as assigned by the Director of the Residential Experience.

## **Qualifications:**

### Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Ability to communicate professionally in person, over the phone, through email, etc.

#### **Education:**

Required: Bachelor's degree.

#### **Experience:**

- Preferred: Experience in residential life and student development academically and professionally.
- Required: Experience in university residence halls.

# **Physical Requirements:**

- Sufficient mobility and stamina to move about campus and engage others. As well as respond to emergencies and crisis intervention.
- Must be a female due to the need for a female role model and to address privacy concerns in an all-female environment.
