Purpose:

Works with and assists plumbers in the repair and maintenance of all domestic boilers, hot water tanks, air, drain lines, natural gas lines, and plumbing systems of Oklahoma Baptist University owned facilities.

Essential Functions:

Under the supervision of a plumber, and as skills are acquired perform the following tasks as assigned:

- Troubleshoot and repair plumbing systems and lines.
- Install and maintain plumbing pipes and fixtures including but not limited to faucets, traps, sinks, washbowls, sewers, vents, and toilet fixtures.
- Cut and thread, galvanized and steel pipe.
- Cut and glue PVC pipe.
- Cut and solder copper pipe.
- Make proper fitting and fixture connections.
- Maintain hot water units and gas fired appliances.
- Perform preventative maintenance to equipment for safety and reliability.
- Any additional duties assigned by the Plumber, Mechanical/Electrical Trades Supervisor, or the Director of Facilities Services.

Qualifications

Required:

- Basic knowledge of plumbing, initiative to learn the trade, and to work safely ability to effectively communicate with co-workers, students, faculty, and administration.
- High school diploma or GED.
- No prior experience required.
- Ability to safely use plumbing related hand tools and power tools as instructed.
- Sit, stand, walk, climb, bend, reach, kneel, and grasp for extended periods of time.
- Ability to safely lift to 80 pounds on a regular basis.
- Ability to safely climb ladders, work at elevated heights, and under houses.
- Possess and maintain a valid Oklahoma driver's license.
- Must be an active member of a local evangelical church.
- Able to pass a pre-employment drug test for a safety sensitive position, based on OBU's drug testing policy.
- Ability to work overtime, and or adjust their schedule as needed when it is deemed necessary by their supervisor.
- Willingness and availability to be subject to on call at any time, day, or night as this person will be required to work after hours, nights and weekends when emergencies arise.

Preferred:

- Some technical school coursework.
- Six months' experience working in a construction related field.

Additional Requirements:

- Must be an active member of a local evangelical church.
- Evangelical is a broad term referring to a segment within Christianity which maintains the authority of the Bible and the belief in salvation by faith in Jesus alone.
