The candidate will also be asked to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in alignment with the candidate's qualifications and University needs. The candidate is also expected to be involved in professional and community activities for the purposes of scholarship, professional development, student advising, recruiting, mentorship, and service.

Essential Functions:

- Witness to Win Chair expectations:
 - Train and mentor students, faculty, and staff to share the gospel biblically, theologically, and practically
 - Regular outreach into various contexts in Oklahoma and beyond to share the gospel
 - o Organize, lead, and execute evangelistic events at OBU and beyond
 - Teach, review, and develop curriculum and classes on evangelism and related topics as needed
 - Produce evangelism research and resources (books, articles, blogs, etc.)
 for students, pastors, and other diverse groups
 - Develop partnerships to further evangelism, church planting, and church revitalization in Oklahoma and beyond (e.g., local churches, the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma, and broader national and global ministries)

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- Assist students in finding and being placed in internships and career opportunities
- Teach other courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels as needed
- Maintain an active program of professional development, including attendance at professional conferences, presentations, and/or scholarly or creative publications
- Student advising, mentoring, and recruitment
- University committee service as assigned
- Other miscellaneous duties as assigned

Required Qualifications:

- Graduate degree in evangelism or a related field
- Be able to organize, plan, and execute a range of events and initiatives in partnership with campus, local, and global ministries
- Be able to effectively communicate with and develop evangelistic skills in young Christians
- Be able to develop strong personal and institutional relationships and partnerships with a wide range of people and entities
- Be proficient in office technology, office software (including various Microsoft tools), and classroom presentation software
- Affirm and teach in accordance with the entirety of the Baptist Faith & Message 2000
- Local church, academic, and personal experience in evangelism and organizing evangelistic efforts
