

LPN to BSN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Complete OBU admission requirements
- Complete School of Nursing admission requirements during the admission period of April 1-30.
- All official transcripts must be received by April 30.
- Completion of a State Board approved LPN program. National accreditation is preferred.
- Submit proof of a current, unencumbered license to practice as an LPN.
- All prerequisite coursework for admission into the professional program of study in nursing must be completed by the end of the spring semester.
- Credit for courses listed below will be held in escrow. The student will receive credit for those courses upon successful completion of the program.
 - NURS 1101 Cornerstone
 - NURS 2013 Development and Nutrition
- Students holding an LPN license may receive credit through an ATI validation exam for the following courses:
 - NURS 3173 Pharmacology
 - NURS 3294 Practicum: Foundations of Professional Nursing Practice
 - NURS 4512 Health Focus: Child & Family
 - NURS 4563 Practicum: Child & Family
- The LPN student must complete the pharmacology and fundamentals ATI exams by July 15 prior to beginning the professional program of study. The child health ATI can be completed prior to the Senior year.
 - The student will have only one opportunity to complete this exam successfully at Level II. Students meeting or exceeding the minimum Level II proficiency on the ATI tests for child health, pharmacology, and/or fundamentals will receive credit for the course upon completion of the exam.
 - Students not scoring at the minimum Level II proficiency on the ATI examination will be expected to enroll and complete the courses associated with the exam on which they did not achieve Level II.
